AI & Me Explorers Club is designed to make artificial intelligence feel approachable, safe, creative, and practical for young learners. Each session introduces one clear AI concept, gives students a hands-on activity, and closes with reflection and sharing to leave learners feeling confident and curious.

# Tiered Learning Path

The same core lessons can be adapted across three tiers so every age group receives the right level of language, activity depth, and challenge.

T1

## Little Explorers

**Ages 5–8**

Focus: color, find, match, imagine, and discover. Activities use big visuals, simple prompts, movement, and playful repetition.

T2

## Creative Explorers

**Ages 9–12**

Focus: create, explain, experiment, and compare. Activities include checklists, short games, prompt practice, and simple design challenges.

T3

## Innovation Explorers

**Ages 13–18**

Focus: discuss, solve, reflect, pitch, and lead. Activities include real-world examples, ethics conversations, business use cases, and innovation challenges.

### JOYPOP THE EXPLORER GUIDE

JoyPop is the friendly mascot and guide for the program, helping students connect with AI concepts through a warm, visual, and memorable character experience.



# Monthly Session Flow

**01** **5 min**  
**Welcome & Warm-Up**  
Smile, set the tone, introduce the theme.

**02** **10–15 min**  
**Mini Lesson**  
Teach one clear AI concept using simple examples.

**03** **25–30 min**  
**Hands-On Activity**  
Create, explore, design, write, or problem-solve.

**04** **5–10 min**  
**Share & Celebrate**  
Let students share, reflect, and receive encouragement.

1	What Is AI?	AI is a helper. Students spot AI in everyday life.
2	AI & Creativity	Use AI and digital tools to create posters, characters, or dream spaces.
3	AI & Storytelling	Create stories, comics, or short scripts with AI-supported ideas.
4	Prompt Power	Learn how better questions create better answers.
5	AI & Music	Brainstorm chants, songs, poems, or affirmation raps.
6	AI & Careers	Explore how AI can support different future careers.
7	AI & Problem-Solving	Use AI to brainstorm solutions to kid-friendly challenges.
8	AI Safety & Smart Choices	Discuss privacy, kindness, accuracy, and responsible use.
9	AI & Community	Imagine how AI could support the neighborhood or school.
10	AI & Business	Create a fun business idea, slogan, flyer, or brand concept.
11	AI for Your Future	Create a future me card, vision board, or goal plan.
12	AI Showcase	Celebrate projects and share what students created or learned.
